The reasons your practice needs a server are:

Storage

All information created from each computer can be stored in one central location so it is easily accessible to all users. The amount of information in a practice can grow quickly especially if digital images need to be stored.

Performance

A server is designed to process information quicker than a normal computer. Because the server is holding all of the information the computers can now run at an optimal level and last for a longer period of time.

Email

All mail, calendaring, contacts and tasks can be controlled by the server.

Remote access

The server allows you to get access to your practice computer from your home or anywhere in the world once an internet connection is available.

Backup

All of this information is backed up to a tape. The tapes are rotated and removed from the practice each evening. In the event of something happening to your practice eg a burglary, fire or flooding all of the practice information is safe.

What is a server?

A server is a system specifically designed to hold, manage, send and process your information.
